Welcome

The Hedgerow is a newly built, detached timber lodge which is ideal for couples looking for a cosy and comfortable place to stay in a stunning location alongside The Ridgeway National Trail. The lodge is chic and stylish with a modern, well equipped kitchen and state of the art shower cabin. Beautifully furnished it has a separate bedroom off the living area with glorious views up to the bank of beech trees that flank The Ridgeway. With a wooden deck to sit out and enjoy an al fresco salad, freshly picked from the Pottager garden and use of “Alice” an original 1950’s vintage caravan as a quirky summerhouse guests may find it difficult to tear themselves away to explore the Chilterns.

At a Glance

Level Access

- The main entrance has 3 steps. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - Bedroom: The Hedgerow has one bedroom described as above.
 - There is one sitting room/lounge in The Hedgerow

Access with steps

- There are steps from the main entrance to:

- The shared garden of The Hedgerow and Thatched Cottage

Bedrooms

- We have non-allergic bedding.

Level access bedrooms

- The route to the bedroom is 750mm wide, or more.
- The bedroom door is 750mm wide, or more.
- There is unobstructed floor space 1200mm by 900mm, or more.

Hearing

- The (bedroom) TVs have subtitles.
- All staff have disability awareness training.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to The Hedgerow at Wainhill by bus and train.
- There is a local bus stop in Chinnor. From Chinnor it is less than half a mile walk across a flat footpath to The Hedgerow. There is also a new bus stop outside Chiltern View on Lower Icknield Way which is less than 2 miles / 3.2 km away on the flat. The bus stop is 0.50 miles / 3.2 km from The Hedgerow at Wainhill.
- The nearest train station is Princes Risborough Station on the Chiltern Line. The train station is 3.2 miles / 5.2 km from The Hedgerow at Wainhill.
- Princes Risborough to London Marylebone is a quick (under 45 minutes) and easy service on the Chiltern Line. The Hedgerow is just 8 minutes drive from the station.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is 1050mm wide, or more.
- The car parking space for The Hedgerow is directly outside the entrance. The whole area is flat and less than 5m from the entrance.

Arrival



Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 1050mm wide, or more.



Main entrance

- The door is 1390mm wide.
- The main entrance has 3 steps.
- The main door is side hung and manual.
- When you arrive, we can help carry your luggage.
- We always meet and greet our guests so can always give a helping hand or take luggage into the lodge.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, bedside lamps, spot lights and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- No bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We use non-allergenic cleaning products and can give details if necessary.
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the right.



Accessible bedrooms

Accessible bedroom The Hedgerow has one bedroom described as above.

- The route to the bedroom is 1570mm wide, or more. The bedroom door is 1570mm wide. There is 1050mm at the side of the bed. The bed is 650mm high. There is 300mm under the bed.
- There is a low clothes rail. You can use the rail sitting down.
- The bedroom is double. The bedroom has an interconnecting room. The bathroom is separate. It is not an ensuite.
- The bathroom door is 585mm wide.
- The bathroom has a separate shower. The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the right. There is 220mm at the side of the toilet.
- There is 910mm in front of the toilet. The toilet seat is 450mm high.
- The basin is 680mm high. There is no space under the basin.



Self catering kitchen

The Hedgerow only has one kitchen

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there is level access.
- The route is 1080mm wide, or more.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- The table is pine topped and the plates are a blue and white china.



Lounge

There is one sitting room/lounge in The Hedgerow

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there is level access. The route is 1390mm wide, or more. The door is 1390mm wide.

Getting around outside

The shared garden of The Hedgerow and Thatched Cottage

- From the main entrance to the area, there are 3 steps.
- There are three wide shallow steps up to the deck of The Hedgerow

Accessibility equipment

- A ramp
- The Hedgerow has a private and secure dog proof garden surrounding the lodge. Assistance dogs are welcome and we provide a dog pack too. There is easy access from the main entrance to the private garden.
- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- We have an electric point and space in our barn.
